Beaufort Lodge two year sires on the march to a Sale complex January 1997.

As shown in the above photograph the Beaufort Lodge deer have tremendous temperament as well as antler and body. Of the 36 two year sires sold on 9th January, 17 were in excess of 200 kg, up to 224 kg.

While Beaufort is renowned for its antler genetics there has been emphasis on body conformation and live weight, always looking to the day when the importance of a high meat to bone ratio's of a carcass will be reflected in premium schedule of the stags to be sold January 98 and 145 prospective spikers weighed in March an average of 133 kg ranging from 94 to 179 kg.


Aside from stags retained into the herd as sires only the best of these stags will be put to auction. These stags at this stage appear to be considerably better than those sold in January 1997.

While the bottom end stags will obviously be culled, the top end continue to improve year by year which is an indication of the generic gain being achieved by Beaufort Lodge.






