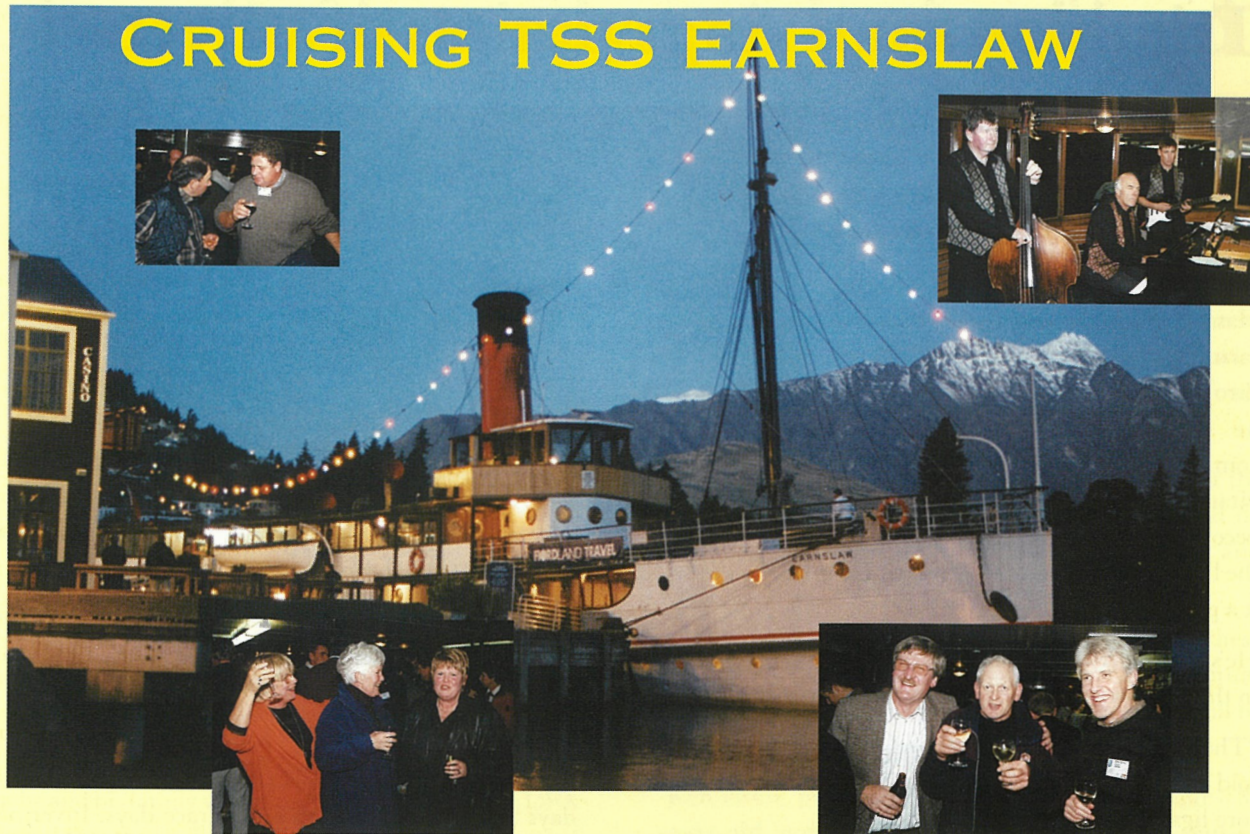


CRUISING TSS EARNSLAW
